

Deputy Chief Minister Punjab Sh. Sukhbir Singh Badal held Interactive Meeting with Key Industrialists and Traders under Progressive Punjab Campaign



Sh. Sukhbir Singh Badal Deputy Chief Minister Punjab held Interactive Meeting with Key Industrialists and Traders under Progressive Punjab Campaign on 15-11-2013 at Hotel Raddison Ludhiana.

In this meeting Sh. Badal announced that:

- A special scheme for industrialists and traders will be introduced shortly vide which they will have to pay only a small lump sum tax on their turn over. The business premises of the traders and industrialists registered under the scheme will not be inspected by any officer without the prior permission of Excise and Taxation Commissioner.
- Industrialists will not have to visit various government departments while seeking approvals for establishing new industrial units under single room window system to be introduced at each district level w.e.f. 01-01-2014. The industrialists will submit online application and registration number will be allotted simultaneously. This system will be monitored by him at state level in association with Industry Minister and a highly dedicated officer. For granting approvals time period will be fixed as under Right to Service Act.
- For addressing industry related issues pertaining to 16 departments, 4 special devoted officers will be appointed for dealing with 4 departments each.
- Punjab will become power surplus state on commencement of 2000 megawatt capacity power plant at Talwandi Sabo on 25-11-2013 and 2000 megawatt capacity thermal plant at Rajpura on 08-12-2013.
- For encouraging new industrial units reduction in Vat, Stamp Duty and Electricity Duty has already been provided.

Upkar Singh Ahuja, Joint Secretary, CICU submitted memorandum to Hon'ble Deputy Chief Minister Punjab highlighting issues relating to Development of Industries, Punjab Small Industries & Export Corporation, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Punjab Pollution Control Board, Municipal Corporation Ludhiana and Improvement Trust Ludhiana.
